Mission Statement

The mission of Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy (A2OCA) is to provide a classical education in an Orthodox Christian environment, in which we actively practice our faith, allowing students to grow to their full human and spiritual potential, with the ability to engage society as mature followers of Jesus Christ. We encourage all families who support our mission statement to apply to join our school family.

Application Fee and Enrollment Fee

There is a one-time application fee of \$50 for new students and an annual enrollment fee of \$30 for new and current students, due at the time of application submission and enrollment. Each fee is payable via FACTS, the independent agency through which parents/guardians can apply/enroll their child(ren) to A2OCA. These fees cover the cost of the FACTS services for the application and student enrollment and other annual administrative costs. These fees are non-refundable. **Please note, that the application and the enrollment fee is waived for families applying for admission to A2OCA in the 2021-2022 school year.**

Tuition and Tuition Assistance

Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy is committed to offering an education that is financially accessible to all families who wish to make A2OCA a part of their and their children's lives. Current tuition is twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000) per year, per child. Discounts are available for multiple children from the same family; 10% for the second child, 20% for the third and subsequent child. There may be the option of a half-day or half-time Pre-K program based on demand, and tuition for this program is six thousand dollars (\$6,500) per year, per child. Please check (✓) the box below if you intend to apply for tuition assistance, and you will be notified when the application is available for you to complete. Please note that the tuition assistance application and assessment is managed by FACTS, which charges \$35 for this service and is due to the agency at the time of submitting your tuition assistance application.

[__] I intend to apply for tuition assistance and understand that the amount that my family qualifies for will be determined by an independent agency and based upon the needs of the family and the tuition assistance funds that are available during the school year being applied for.

Tuition Payments

To secure your child(ren)'s enrollment, the first month's tuition payment (\$1,000) is due by May 15th of the school year being applied for or in the case of enrollment after May 15th, this payment is due at the time of submission of the enrollment form. If paying this amount by check, please make checks payable to 'St. Vladimir Orthodox Church,' and in the memo indicate 'School tuition.' This fee is non-refundable after June 30th. For our inaugural year there is a tuition discount of \$500 for each student whose completed application and supporting documents are submitted by the extended deadline of June 15th (including the first month's tuition payment), which will be applied to the student's account upon receipt of all documents. If you intend to apply for tuition assistance, this amount will be deducted from the total tuition amount that your family qualifies for, and you will be responsible to pay the remaining balance, which will be divided equally among 11 monthly tuition payments, the first of which is due by June 30th and the remainder of which are due by the end of each calendar month thereafter (e.g., July 31st, August 31st, September 30th, etc.) and the final tuition payment for the school year is due by April 30th. For students who enroll past the first month of the school year, tuition is prorated and will be communicated accordingly. Paying tuition in full or

dividing payments into bi-annual or bi-monthly payments is also an option. If you experience difficulty in making a tuition payment, please reach out to us as soon as you are able to, so that we can work together to find a solution.

Additional Fees

Tuition Fees include the cost of books from Pre-K to 3rd Grade. Beginning in 4th Grade, there is a fee for consumable curriculum materials that parents/guardians are responsible for. In addition to tuition, additional fees include the cost of uniforms, field trips, private lessons, and before- or after-school care. More information about each of these additional fees will be communicated to parents/guardians as more information about them becomes available.

Eligibility for Enrollment

To be eligible for enrollment in Pre-K, a child must turn 4 years old on or before September 1st of the school year being applied for and must be potty-trained. To be eligible for enrollment in Kindergarten, a child must turn 5 years old on or before September 1st of the school year being applied for. A child who turns the age of eligibility (for either Pre-K or Kindergarten) between September 2nd and December 1st (inclusive) may, also, be eligible for enrollment if parents/guardians complete and submit the Application for Early Admission to Pre-K and Kindergarten - Waiver Form.

Pre-K Program

Ann Arbor Orthodox Classical Academy seeks to garner from parents/guardians their interest in each of the following Pre-K program options, so that it can develop a Pre-K program that meets the needs of most families. If you wish to enroll your child in the Pre-K program, please indicate which of the following programs interest you (please select all options that work for your family by numbering your choices in the order of your preference; e.g., 1, 2, 3, 4).

3rd and 4th Grade

In our inaugural year, we will offer Pre-K to 2nd Grade. The availability of 3rd and 4th grade will be based upon whether we have a sufficient number of enrolled students (3 students for each grade for a mixed-grade class or 6 students per grade for a single-grade class). If you wish to enroll your child(ren) for 3rd or 4th grade, please indicate so here, while also completing and submitting the application form and supporting documents. You do not need to submit the first month's tuition payment (\$1,000) until you receive notification from the school (by June 30th, 2021) that these grades will be offered for the 2021-2022 school year, in which case the first month's tuition payment will be due by July 15th, 2021.

Missing information may delay the processing of your application and inaccurate information may be grounds for rejection of an application or dismissal of a student. Applications are considered complete when submitted with supporting documentation (as outlined in the 'Supporting Documentation' section) and when all sections are filled in appropriately and accurately. Please indicate a 'N/A' for sections that do not apply to your situation. You are responsible to ensure your application is complete and accurate prior to its submission. Upon your child's admission to A2OCA, you will be notified if there are any additional forms that need to be completed and submitted. At a later date, your student(s) will be invited to complete an entrance assessment to determine the student's readiness for the curriculum.
